Information on Current Employer

Sri Kota Specialist Medical Centre is a tertiary private medical centre in Klang, Malaysia.

It is a 9 storey building with 232 beds fully equipped with modern facilities.

It is multidisciplinary consist of medical, surgical, orthopaedic, neurology, obstetrics and gynaecology, paediatric, cardiology and cardiothoracic, gastroenterology, oral facio-maxillary, haematology, endocrine medicine, urology and oncology.

There are 275 nursing staff, 200 non-medical staff in Sri Kota Specialist Medical Centre. Bed occupancy rate per day is about 80%, 6 OR functioning every day, 200 outpatient per day and minimal of 3 delivery per month.

The Infection Control Team members includes the Infection Control Chairman, Infection Control Nurse In-Charge, 1 Infection Control Nurse, 13 Infection Control Link Nurses.

Infection Control Unit is responsible to ensure a healthy and safe environment by preventing hospital acquired infection among patients, staffs and visitor. The Infection Control Team also will ensure every healthcare worker understand and implement hospital infection control practices and will continuously monitor, evaluate and audit on the infection control practices among healthcare worker.

The Infection Control Unit also will review outbreaks of infection and advice managers on how outbreaks might be managed and prevented.

Specific Skills related to the positions

Clinical

- 1. Liaise closely with the clinician and microbiologist.
- 2. Supervise and advise on isolation techniques policies and procedures generally and in specific clinical situations.
- 3. Provide clinical advice and support nurses, midwives, health visitors and other non-clinical personnel on infection control issues.
- 4. Analyse and provide feedback on microbiology reports to head of department.
- 5. Provide clinical advice and support to other healthcare professionals, ancillary staff and external agencies concerned with social issues arising from infection control matters.
- 6. Provide guidance and support to the Infection Control Link Nurses.

Surveillance:

- 1. Coordinate surveillance activities for the hospital.
- 2. Collect relevant information on behalf of the Infection Control Team including point prevalence studies on hospital acquired infections, clinical and antibiotic audits and hand hygiene compliance.

Coordination/Organization of Activities

- Identify potential infection hazards and suggest appropriate remedial action to relevant personnel.
- 2. Work with Infection Control Team to identify, investigate and control outbreaks of infection.
- 3. Collaborate with the Infection Control Team and clinicians about the routine monitoring of units, such as the intensive care and special care nursery, particularly vulnerable to infection.
- 4. Involved in preschool activity (Hand Hygiene Lesson for the pre-schoolers).

Administrative

- 1. Participate in the development and implementation of the infection control policies.
- 2. Monitor compliance with infection control policies, including activities directly associated with audit.
- 3. Preparing timely report.
- 4. Advice staff on the various aspects of infection control and occupational health safety.

Education :

- 1. Participate in informal and formal teaching programs for all healthcare workers.
- 2. Keep abreast with recent advances by reading relevant literature and attending appropriate courses, meetings and exhibitions.
- 3. Advice staff with regards to the microbiologic hazards in occupation health safety.
- 4. Participate and coordinate infection control-related educational campaigns as instructed by the Infection Control Committee.

Research and Quality Improvement Activities

- 1. Participate with the microbiologist and appropriate clinical staff on research projects that related to hospital infection.
- 2. Evaluate implementation of infection control techniques.
- 3. Audit infection control activities.

- 15. Act as specialist resource in providing infection control knowledge and expertise to hospital management, nursing and all healthcare personnel.
- 16. Ensure that all infection control policies, guidelines and procedures are research/evidence based and that they are updated as required.
- 17. Make recommendations for change and improvements in infection control practice.
- 18. Plan, negotiate with and support staff to implement and changes necessary.
- 19. Advise senior hospital management and the multi-disciplinary team on recent advances in infection control and prevention when and where appropriate.
- 20. Advise and participate in the commissioning, tendering and purchasing of patient care and medical equipment as pertaining to infection prevention / control.
- 21. Provide infection prevention / control advice to committees established to oversee capital projects, renovations and refurbishments within the hospital.
- 22. Liaise with Occupational Health Staff and the Health and Safety Officer on relevant staff health issues.
- 23. Participate in the formulation of policies, guidelines, standards and procedures for infection control and prevention, with members of the Infection Control Team and other relevant staff, including defining areas of special risk.
- 24. Advise committees on procedures, practices, techniques and materials to control and prevent infection.
- 25. Participate in the development of the Infection Control service / programme.
