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Executive Biography

Aznul Rizal Shahid is the Head of Sustainability & ESG with Avaland Berhad, a public listed property developer based in USJ, Selangor. His primary responsibility is to lead the strategic sustainability initiatives of the company towards ESG roadmap. He plays an active role in crafting Avaland's sustainability framework, which serves as the guide to support the operation team.

Aznul joined Avaland in 2019, instrumental in driving the environmental stewardship of the company through sustainable practices in enhancing ecosystem resilience, urban biodiversity and human wellbeing. The primary responsibility in spearheading the Sustainability Department centered on the formulation of Corporate Sustainability Framework and the Project Green Plan. Aznul has successfully established internal/in-house capability of GreenHouse Gas (Carbon Footprint) Accounting in tracking Scope 1, 2 and 3 emissions. In line with the national's commitment as per 2015 Paris Agreement, he effectively crafted the Group's decarbonization roadmap towards 45% carbon intensity reduction in 2030 and net zero in 2050. This includes various strategic initiatives and operational implementation encompassing the reduced electricity campaign, renewable energy and carbon sequestration.

Under Aznul's leadership, he has overseen the annual Sustainability Reporting that leads to **4-star rating by FTSE4Good Index Bursa Malaysia** in 2024. This was achieved through the systematic focus on the relevant sustainability indicators, with strategic focus on the 'big ticket items' such as Environmental Supply Chain, Climate Change & Energy. The sustainability framework formulated by him also facilitated towards securing the SUKUK Green Bond & Financing program by Ambank.

Prior to joining Avaland, Aznul held the position of Lead Design Manager with Turner International; the world's leading Project Management Team in delivering the PNB 118 Retail Mall and Four Seasons Hotel in KL. He spearheaded the team in driving the Design Consultants towards a lifestyle and cost-effective retail spaces which will compete along with the other upcoming retail malls such as Lalaport (BBCC) and TRX Mall. Working alongside the top design experts in the country, he managed to extract the best of design and engineering practices in achieving a contemporary 'look & feel' of the scheme.
